



#### TOOLS:

- Heavyweight crepe paper
  - Green + Petal colour
- 16/18 gauge paper covered wire x 3
- Tacky glue
   Cocktail stick
- Detail scissors
- Pliers
- Floral tape
- Pan Pastel (optional)
- Sponge (optional)

# Outreach


